

**KEEPING SAFE
AT TRINITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH
DURING PANDEMIC**

We want you and your neighbours to be safe while praising the Lord during the COVID-19 pandemic.

It is imperative you follow these mandatory protocols:

- If you are not well, remain at home and join us for Sunday service on ZOOM.
- Register your intention to attend church with the church office by the Thursday prior to each service. This will allow us to have your seats ready and help with tracking and tracing if needed. Numbers will be limited, but folks who miss the cut will be at the top of the list for the following Sunday.
- Visitors will be asked for name, address and telephone number for tracking if needed. The records will be kept as long as necessary, then destroyed to protect privacy.
- Please wear a mask. Bring your own or disposable masks will be available at the church.
- Respect physical distancing of two metres or six feet while moving about except with family cohorts.
- Children are to remain with their family members as there will be no Sunday School.
- Sanitize your hands when entering and leaving the church.
- We will be enjoying music and the Praise team, but to keep us safe there will be no group singing.
- There will be no responsive reading.
- No food or beverages will be served in the church for now.
- Follow Elder's direction on leaving the church building after the Service.
- You are welcome to join in safe fellowship with your church family outside of the church building. We want to hear how you are doing!
