#### SUNDAY WORSHIP SERVICE - JUNE 19, 2022

Sermon – "Your Father's Good Advice" (Rev. Dr. Victor Lujetic) Scripture – <u>Proverbs 4:1-5</u>

Our guest minister for the last few weeks has been Rev. Dr. Victor Lujetic. Victor is a retired Baptist minister who was born and raised in the United States. He has served congregations in Ottawa and Toronto, as well as in Maryland, Virginia, and New York. Victor will be continuing to preach throughout the summer months at Trinity.
