SUNDAY WORSHIP SERVICE — SEPTEMBER 4, 2022

Sermon – "A But-If-Not Faith" (Rev. Dr. Victor Lujetic)

Scripture – Daniel 3:13-18

We are pleased that Rev. Dr. Victor Lujetic will be with us at Trinity on Sunday; Victor will continue to join us for worship for the next few weeks. Victor is a retired Baptist minister, born and raised in the United States. He has served congregations in Ottawa, Toronto, as well as in the US.

TRINITY'S UPDATED COVID PROTOCOLS — JUNE 19, 2022

Beginning on June 19, 2022, Trinity's Session has approved the following:

COVID Protocols Lifted
