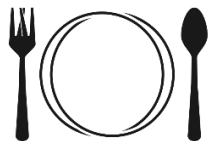

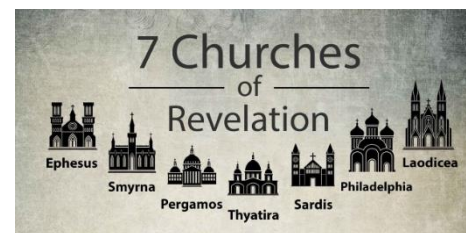

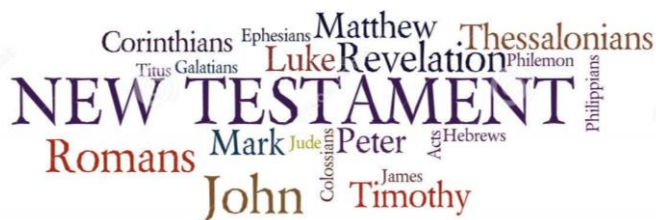
INTRODUCTION TO THE NEW TESTAMENT
