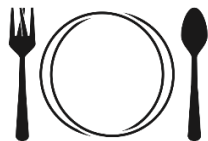

INTRODUCTION TO THE NEW TESTAMENT

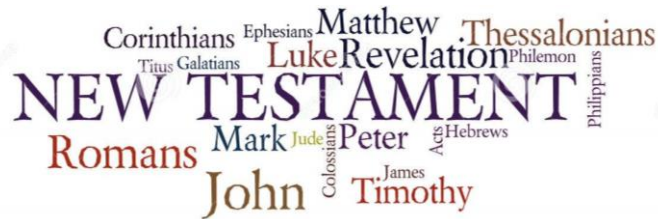
- every Thursday morning 9:30 AM – 11 AM

LOOKING AHEAD ...



All Saints' Sunday is a day set aside to remember, with thanksgiving to God, those people in our lives who were pillars of faith and love, and who have passed away to be with the Lord.

Presbyterian tradition does not often make a big deal of All Saints' Day, but this year we would like to give the congregation an opportunity to celebrate and give thanks to God for dear ones who showed us God's grace and love in their lives and who have now gone to glory. On November 5, you are invited to bring a picture (in a self-standing frame) of a loved one (or a few) from your own life whom you would like to remember before God and give thanks for. Bring those pictures of loved ones with you to church on November 5.



In preparation for our Anniversary Sunday, please write down a short paragraph of how you personally have seen, heard, or experienced God's obvious involvement in the building, rebuilding, or the on-going ministry of Trinity Presbyterian Church across the years. It just needs to be a few lines or, at most, a paragraph. These stories will be read on Anniversary Sunday.

Here is an example I recently heard:

On the day the steeple was to be lifted into place on the new Church, it was cold and windy and rainy. We spent a fortune on a crane for a few hours, but the weather conspired to make lifting the steeple into place a dangerous, if not impossible, task. When the appointed time came to raise the steeple, and everything was ready, all of a sudden the rain stopped, the wind died down, and the sun came out, and for a few moments, all was calm – just long enough to lift the steeple into place and secure it. As soon as it was up, the stormy weather returned. God opened a little window of calm to help us get the steeple up. It seems God knew what we needed when we needed it and so He provided!
