Receipts for Reimbursement:


Please submit all receipts for 2023, as per the finance policies, by 12 Noon on January 14, 2024.



You will need to fill out the reimbursement form fully (name, signature, receipts, etc.), get the

appropriate approval signatures (scanning & e-mailing them to the appropriate person and then having them print, sign, scan & send it back to you is allowed) and have a copy of a cheque to your account (if not previously done).

2023 Annual Reports: As 2023 draws to a close and 2024 is about to begin, we pause to look back on the year that has been. Part of this process is through our Annual General Meeting. A date for Trinity's Annual General Meeting will be communicated in the new year.

In preparation for that meeting, we will be preparing an annual reports package for the congregation. Committee reports and other submissions for the 2023 Annual Report need to be submitted by Sunday, January 14, 2024. Offering Envelopes: Due to rising costs and declining usage, Trinity has decided to discontinue purchasing the boxes of numbered envelopes. However, if envelopes are your preferred method of giving, please continue to do so. We will also continue to give out envelope boxes to anyone who wants to start using them. You can get one by contacting Brent Robinson. We have a large stockpile of unused boxes so we should be able to keep people supplied for at least the next 10 years, probably much longer, so feel free to continue with your preferred method of giving, whether that be PAR, Interac Transfers, or Envelopes.

The last purchased (2024) envelopes will be available for pickup at the January 7 service, weather permitting. Starting at the end of next year, we will use a different method for distributing them. While recording the offerings, Brent can track how many envelopes each person uses, so if it looks like you're about to run low, you will receive some more in your family folder. They will not be for the current year, but the date on the envelopes is not important, just the envelope number, which of course identifies who made the offering. It's easy for envelopes to go missing, so if you're concerned you might run out beforehand, just let Brent know and he will get you re-supplied.

A lot of you likely have leftover 2023 envelopes, or ones from earlier years. Please feel free to use them as well, and that'll stretch out our supply even further.

These changes apply to the numbered envelopes only, and do not affect the visitor envelopes, which are in the backs of the seats each service.
