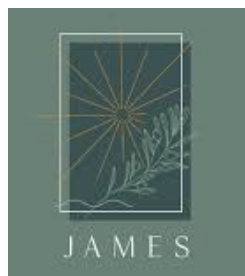
Dave’s regular office hours will be 9 AM – 12 Noon, Tuesday to Friday.
