Looking to buy gift cards for anyone on your Christmas list? We are running the Fundscrip program again this year.

If you want to give gift cards to family or friends, ordering them through Trinity's Fundscrip account is the best way to do it. There are over 200 retailers available for Ontario and Trinity will earn between 2% - 10%, depending on the retailer. You lose nothing – you buy gift cards at face value and you get face value when you redeem them. Trinity gets a certain percentage back from each retailer.

Two orders will be placed this year, with the first one due by December 1, 2024 at 5 pm, to receive the cards December 8, 2024. Order form (see attachment to weekly email) can be handed to Deb Hickey at church or email your order to her. Payment can be made by eTransfer to info.trinity.kanata@gmail.com or by cheque payable to Trinity Presbyterian Church. Grocery cards should continue to be ordered through Marilyn O'Brien.
